Every year the Tioga County Water Quality Coordinating Committee holds a stream cleanup event in the spring. The event is open to community organizations, groups or individuals that would like to cleanup a stream of their choice as a service project or just to help cleanup the environment. Our stream cleanup dates every year coincide with the National River Cleanup Week. Participants are supplied with trash bags and awarded t-shirts for their cleanup efforts. The Soil and Water Conservation District coordinates pick up of the trash with the local highway departments and has it transported to Taylor's Garbage Service for ultimate disposal.
